Board Meeting – June 10, 2026, at 7:00 PM

The East Duchesne Culinary Water Improvement District (EDCWID) board meeting was called to order by the Chairman Matthew G Betts, at 7:00 pm.

Discussion & Consideration of Yearly Open Meeting Act:

This is a reminder to make sure the board members have all their training done.

Minutes:

The board reviewed the minutes of May 13, 2026, regular meeting. Board member Connie Sweat motioned to approve the minutes for the regular board meeting. Vice Chairman Chet Hansen seconded the motion. All board members voted aye and the motion passed.

Review of Budgets, Accounts Payable, Bank Statements, and Payroll, Etc.

Board Member Connie Sweat motioned to approve the accounts payable, bank statements, and payroll as presented. Board member Chet Clayburn seconded the motion. All board members present voted aye and the motion passed.

Review of usage for Crescent Energy/Javelin Per Contract:

The water is still shut off. Josh has been told that they would like to have turned back on next week. It has been reviewed.

Discussion & Consideration of Victory Pipeline – Clyde Watkins:

Clyde Watkins from Duchesne County Water Conservation District stated the Victory Pipeline had a break few weeks ago. It was down for approximately 16 days. They could not get parts for the victory water pipeline, and it caused some real issues. They have tried to have some parts made, but that did not work out so well either. At the time of the break, he was able to back-feed some water to Johnson Water. That will not be done in the future. He would like to make sure everyone has parts to their systems on hand, so this type of situation does not occur again. He would like to start conversations/discussions so everyone can work together to help one another.

Wes Hanberg from Johnson Water District stated that he does not know if there has been an official contract between Johnson Water District and East Duchesne Culinary Water Improvement District. He would like to get that taken care of, so it is officially done. He would also like to start conversations with East Duchesne Culinary Water Improvement District and suggests that the other districts find time in August to start those conversations.

Discussion & Consideration of Water Line for Russell DeWar:

Russell DeWar asked if the board had the chance to look at the plat map that was provided last month. He would like to put in a 2" line. Vice Chairman Chet Hansen motioned to approve the line for Russell DeWar. Board member Chet Clayburn seconded the motion. All board members present voted aye and the motion passed.

Discussion & Consideration of Getting Water on Blue Bench – Jeff Crozier:

Jeff Crozier stated Crescent Energy (Javelin) would like to start conversations about getting a 2" pipeline put in close to 5000 South. They would like to have a filling station or a bigger pipeline. Chairman Matt Betts stated the problem isn't the pipeline or water, it is the water rights that would be associated with it. The board decided that they would like to think about it.

Discussion & Consideration of Water Line to House – Lex Fabrizio:

Lex Fabrizio did not show up for the meeting. It was decided that District Manager Josh Byrnes would talk with Lex Fabrizio and see exactly what was wanted.

Discussion & Consideration of Land Purchase:

District Manager Josh Byrnes stated that Ronald & Martha Weimer came in to sign but decided to wait until they read the purchase agreement better and that they would like a little bit more money for the 1.425 acre that the district would like to purchase. Chairman Matt Betts stated that the additional amount could be added onto the \$7,000 that was the original amount. The total would come to \$9,975.

Update from Forsgren Engineering Jason Broome on Various Projects:

Utahn Pipeline & Tank:

Jason Broome from Forsgren Engineering stated that they need to issue the certificate of completion. JRock needs to get the rest of the documents owed to the district, this includes the warranty information.

Blue Bench Pump Station:

Jason Broome stated that they have reached out to Moon Lake Electric to plan for electricity for the pump station. The board asked Jason to reach out to Mountainland to find out why they want us to pay more than the 20% that is in the contract.

Blue Bench Pipeline

Jason stated they are still working on getting all the easements in place. The drawing for the pipeline is complete.

Updates from District Manager:
